

**Marriage:** The Archdiocese of Winnipeg requires at least six months notice prior to the wedding. In addition, you must also be a registered member in good standing. Marriage Preparation Course obligatory.

**Baptism:** You must be a registered member in good standing for a minimum of three months prior to scheduling your child's baptism

**Confession**: every day before Mass and every 1st Friday of the month from 5:00 P.M. or 6:00 P.M. depending on the schedule of the Mass.

Sick: a Priest may be called in an emergency at all times.
