FIRST SUNDAY OF ADVENT



NEW LITURGICAL YEAR - December 3, when we begin the new Liturgical Year - Year B on the 1st Sunday of Advent. During the four weeks before Christmas we look to the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ as our Saviour. It is a time of expectant preparation for the celebration of Christmas. We observe it as a season of prayer, fasting and repentance. The words of the prophet Isaiah tell of the coming of a judge who will help people from all nations to surrender their weapons and make peace. And in that peace, we are told to choose light over darkness. That light is the coming of Christ, for whom we "must be ready, for the Son of Man is coming at an unexpected hour." We are called to be watchful: "You do not know when the time will come"; "Beware, keep alert"; "Keep awake." These passages call us to be attentive in our every moment. A message of hope—the coming of a Saviour and the key to preparing for eternity.

ADVENT WREATH - Set on the branches of the wreath are 4 candles: 3 purple and 1 pink representing the coming of the light of Christ into the world. On the 1st Sunday of Advent, the 1st purple candle is lit—the "Prophecy Candle" in remembrance of the prophets, primarily Isaiah, who foretold the birth of Christ. On the 2nd Sunday of Advent, the 2nd purple candle is lit representing love. On the 3rd Sunday of Advent, also known as Gaudete Sunday, meaning "to rejoice" the pink candle is lit representing joy. On the 4th Sunday of Advent, the 4th candle is lit, representing peace.
