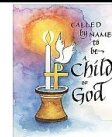

**RADIO MARIA FAMILY** will be having a meeting on Sunday, November 12 following the evening Mass.

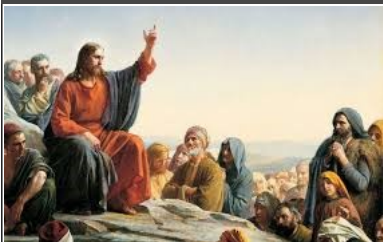
**HOLY GHOST FRATERNAL AID SOCIETY** will be having a meeting on Sunday, November 19 at 2:30 p.m. at their building.
