REMEMBRANCE DAY - on **November 11** we pause in silence to remember those who died in war, particularly in and since World War I. Armies stopped fighting on Nov 11th at 11:00 am in 1918 (the eleventh hour of the eleventh month). By wearing our poppies on this day, we honour the war dead and veterans, ex-service personnel and their dependents.

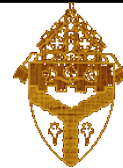
