PRESENTATION OF THE LORD

Is celebrated on **Thursday, February 2**. On that day there will a 7:00pm Mass in our Church instead of the morning Mass in Polish Manor. The blessing of the candles will take place following each Mass. Historical roots of this tradition are taken from the Gospel of St. Luke (Lk 2, 22-38). According to the law, every firstborn boy was to be offered to God in the Temple. This was a symbolic gesture of consecration to God which held great value for the parents. The presentation of Jesus was an expression of fidelity to God, to his precepts contained in the Law, but above all in this event, Jesus offers himself to God his Father, because, being a man, he does not cease to be one of the Trinity.

THE FEAST OF ST BLAISE

Is celebrated on **February 3**. Throats will be blessed after each Mass that day. Tradition says that through the intercession of Saint Blaise, Bishop and Martyr, God delivers us from any disease of the throat and from every other illness.
