Marriage: The Archdiocese of Winnipeg requires at least six months notice prior to the wedding. In addition, you must also be a registered parishioner in good standing. Marriage Preparation Course obligatory.

Baptism: You should be a registered member in good standing for a minimum of three months prior to scheduling your child's baptism.

Confession: every day before Mass and every 1st Friday of the month from 5:30 PM until 7:00 PM.

Sick: a Priest may be called in an emergency at all times.

We invite everyone to participate in Rosary Devotions during the month of October on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday at 6:30 pm.

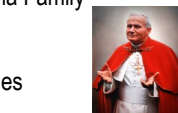
CHILDREN MINISTRY - every Sunday, during the 9:30 am Mass we invite all children to participate in Children's Liturgy meetings.

HOLY GHOST PARISH CEMETERY FUND - on **Sunday, November 9** there will be a collection in support of our Cemetery Fund. As a parish, we are responsible for the maintenance and upkeep of our cemeteries. We have continued with the foundation repair this year, replaced the Calvary steps and expanded the path around our Columbarium. We have plans to further beautify this area with plants and benches. We will be installing three new benches around the Columbarium in the spring of 2026 and we are looking for bench sponsors. The cost of one bench is about \$2,500.00. If you, as individual, family or organization, would like to support this cause, please contact our parish office. We also have plans for Addis cemetery which is our backup for when there is no more room for burials in our Main Street cemetery. At present we are exploring our options for mapping and dividing the land into plots. We will be informing you of steps taken. All proceeds from the Cemetery Fund collection will help us cover these expenses and continue future work. We are asking for your support which will help our cemetery maintain its beautiful appearances as the final resting place for our faithful departed. There are pink envelopes in your Sunday offertory envelopes for this collection. Thank you and God bless all for your support and understanding. A reminder that starting on November 10, all flowers and candles left on the grass or Calvary will be removed. If you wish to keep your candles or flowers, please remove them before that date. Also, please do not leave rocks, small objects, flowers or candles in the Columbarium. **We thank you for your respect and cooperation.**
