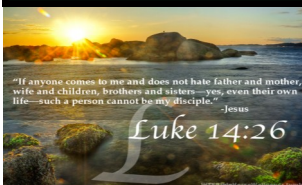

PAINTING OF THE CHURCH - So far we have collected **\$236,280.00**. We received an estimate of the project through Bridgeland Builders. They provided us with a detail Statement of Work and prove to be very competent. Based on their estimate the total cost of this project will be **\$452,299.50**. The main church will be done in two phases, but in order to start that work we need **\$349,129.40** – which means we are **\$112,849.40** away from the beginning of the project! Phase three (\$103,170.10) includes work done in the chapel and the two vestibules. Further donations can be made in the blue envelopes marked "Painting".
